Declaration According to REACH and CLP Regulation for BrüggemannAlcohol products

Under REACH Regulation (EC) 1907/2006, L. Brüggemann GmbH & Co. KG (designated here as BRÜGGEMANN) take on the roles of manufacturer, importer, and also the role of downstream user. The product portfolio has not changed, even after the 2018 registration period, due to the effects of the REACH regulation.

Registration

All substances and raw materials requiring registration in the BRÜGGEMANN product portfolio in 2010 (phase I), 2013 (phase II) and 2018 (phase III) were registered by BRÜGGEMANN or by the relevant suppliers in good time. The registration numbers of substances classified as hazardous are specified in the safety data sheets. For other substances information is made available in accordance with Article 32 of the REACH Regulation.

SVHC: Substances of Very High Concern

The European Chemicals Agency ECHA has drawn up a list of substances of very high concern (SVHC), Candidate list. This SVHC list is updated about every 6 months with the recent issue decided and updated on **July 08th 2021**. Substances included on this list include CMR substances in categories 1A and 1B, PBT and vPvB, and endocrine disruptors. SVHC substances are candidates for an authorization or restriction procedure under the REACH Regulation. If a product contains an SVHC substance above the consideration limit, BRÜGGEMANN will immediately comply with the obligation to communicate as stipulated in Article 33 of the REACH Regulation by providing this information on the associated safety data sheet.

Today the above mentioned **BrüggemannAlcohol products** do not contain any substances from the SVHC list above the threshold limit for reporting of 1000 ppm.

BrüggemannAlcohol products are classified, labeled, and packaged in accordance with the CLP Regulation (EC) 1272/2008.

The data indicated above are the results of our investigations and correspond to the state-of-the-art. The data refer to the state of the laws at the date of issue. This confirmation expires after 12 months or in case of regulatory changes. Please ask for a new confirmation if needed.
